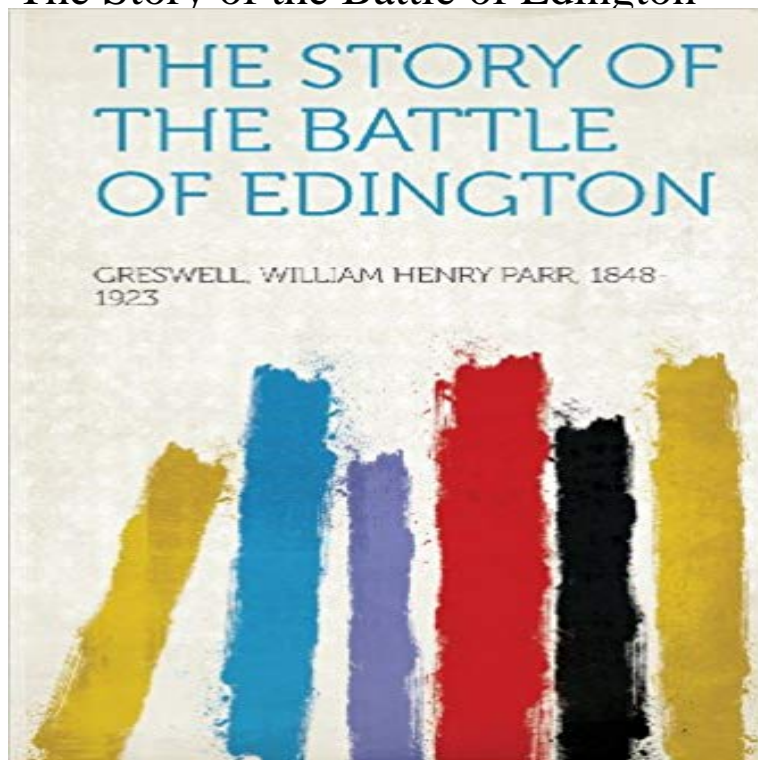


The Story of the Battle of Edington
