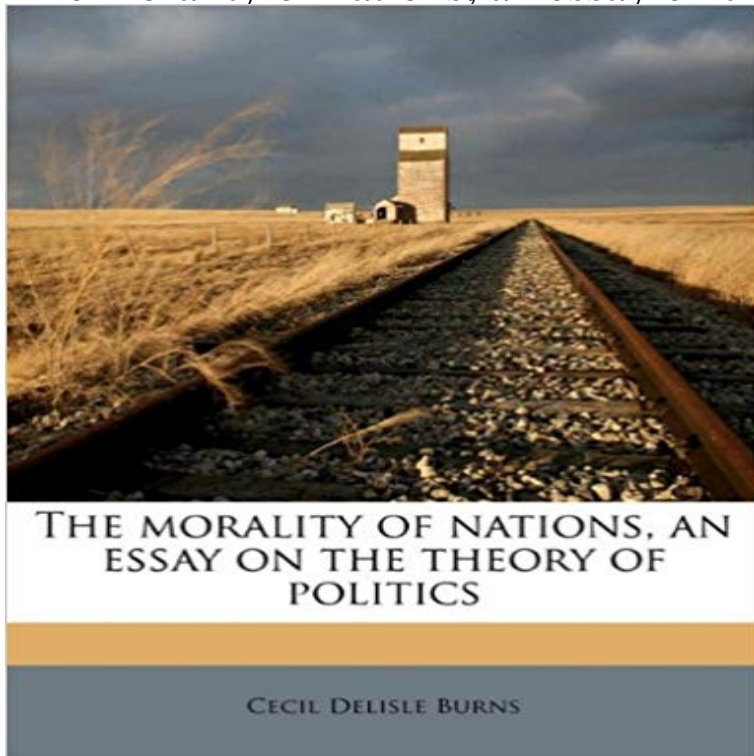


## The morality of nations, an essay on the theory of politics
