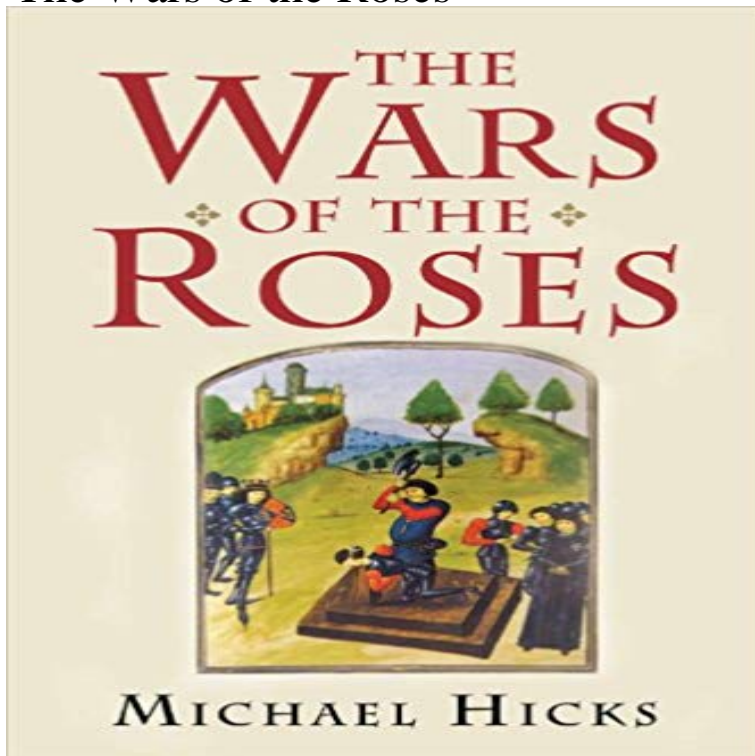


## The Wars of the Roses
