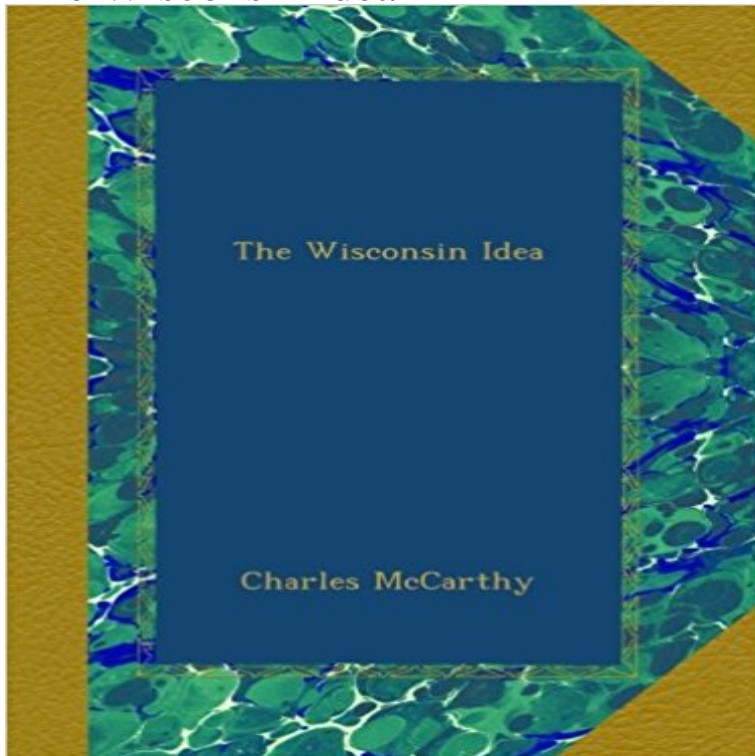


The Wisconsin Idea
