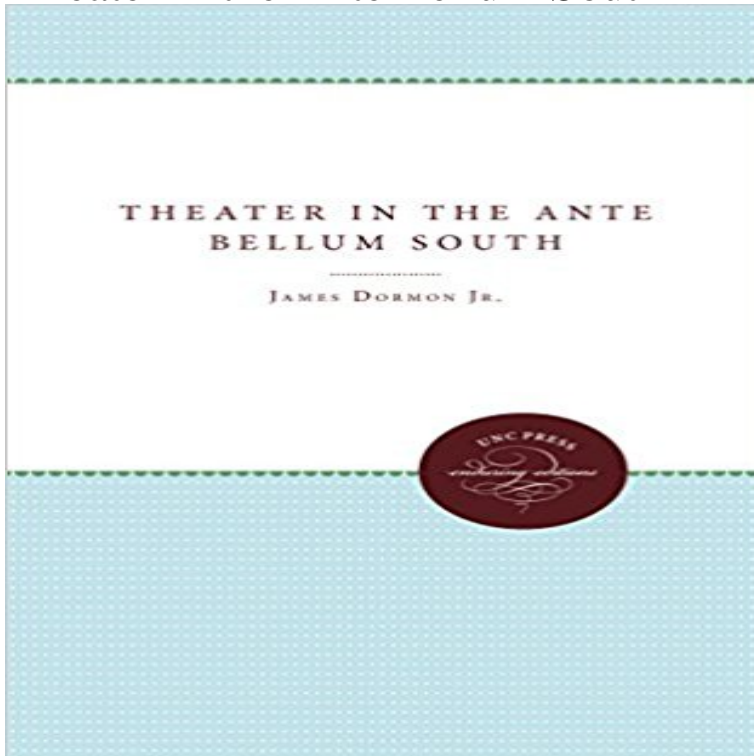


Theater in the Ante Bellum South
