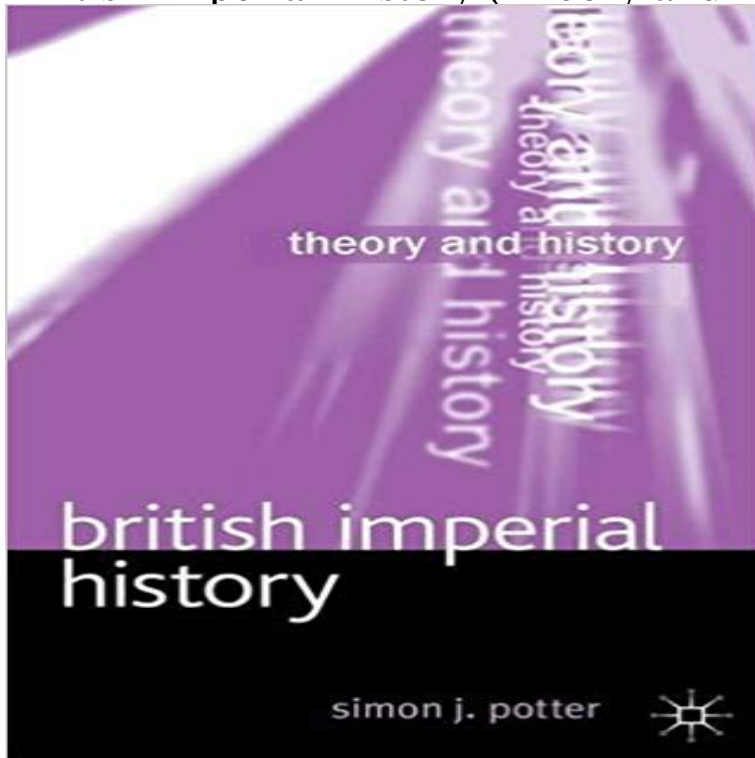


British Imperial History (Theory and History)
