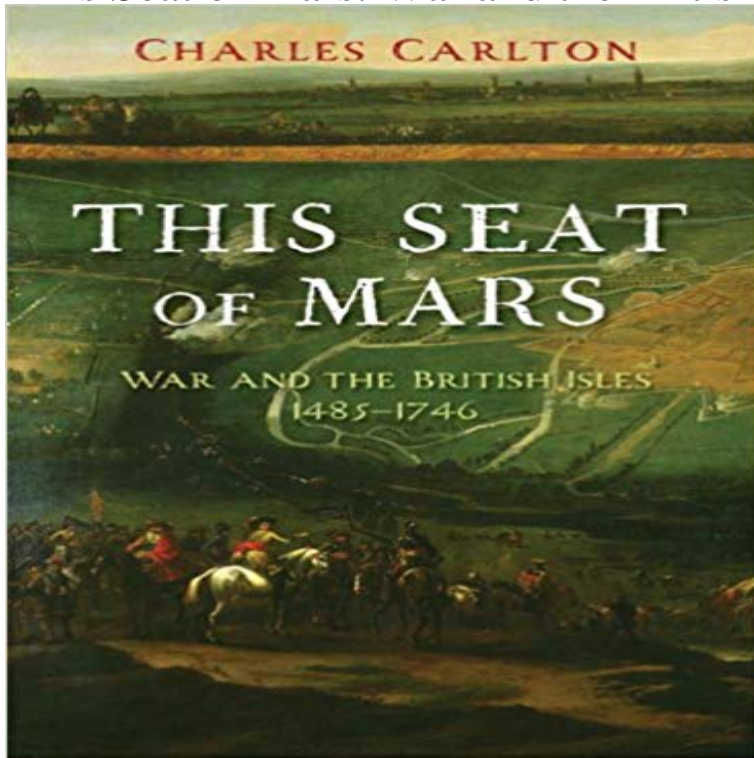


This Seat of Mars: War and the British Isles, 1485-1746

Chapters alternate, providing a robust military and political narrative interlaced with accounts illuminating the personal experience of war, from recruitment to the end of battle in discharge or death. Carlton expertly charts the remarkable military developments over the period, as well as wars enduring corollaries: camaraderie, courage, fear, and grief to give a powerful account of the profound effect of war on the British Isles and its peoples.
