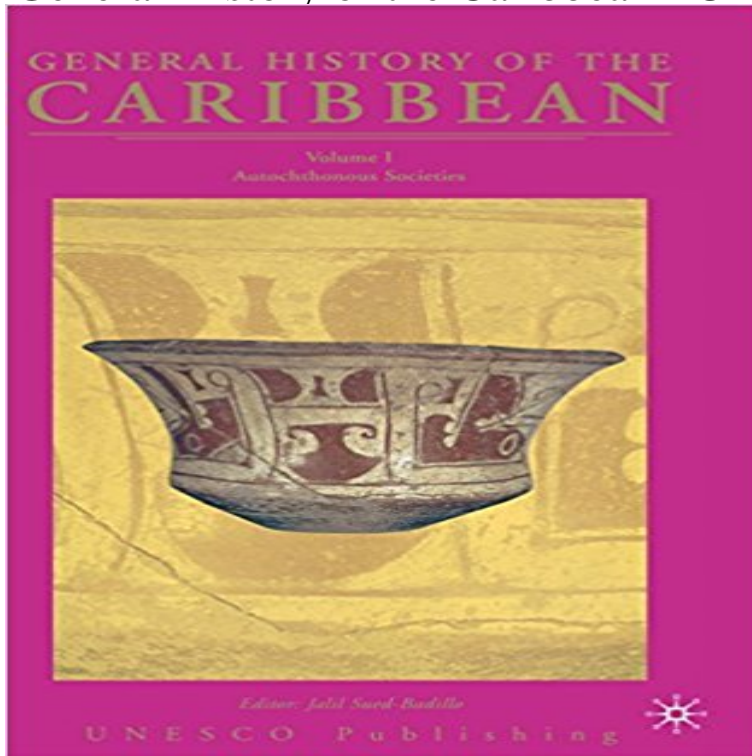


## General History of the Caribbean - UNESCO: Autochthonous Societies
