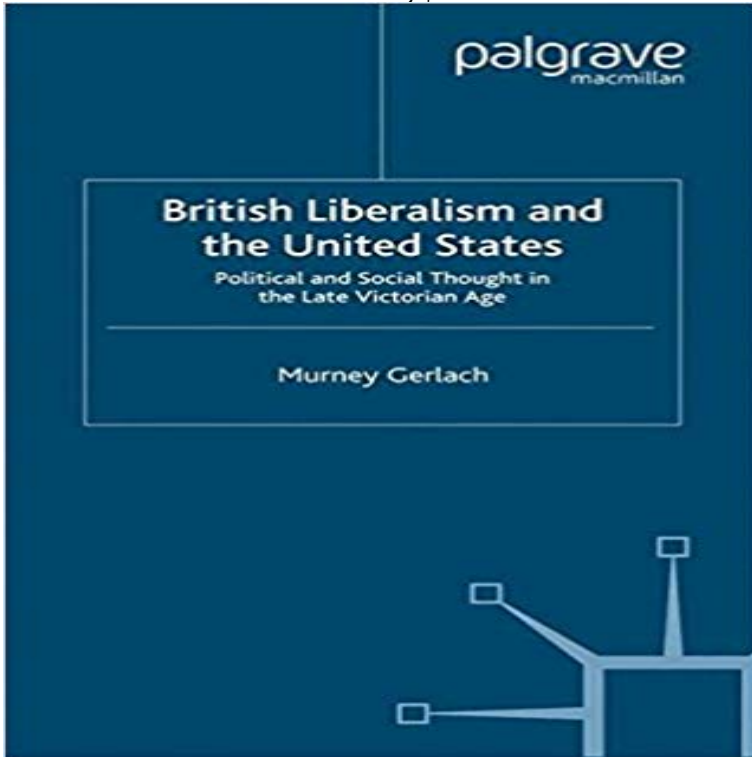


British Liberalism and the United States: Political and Social Thought in the Late Victorian Age
