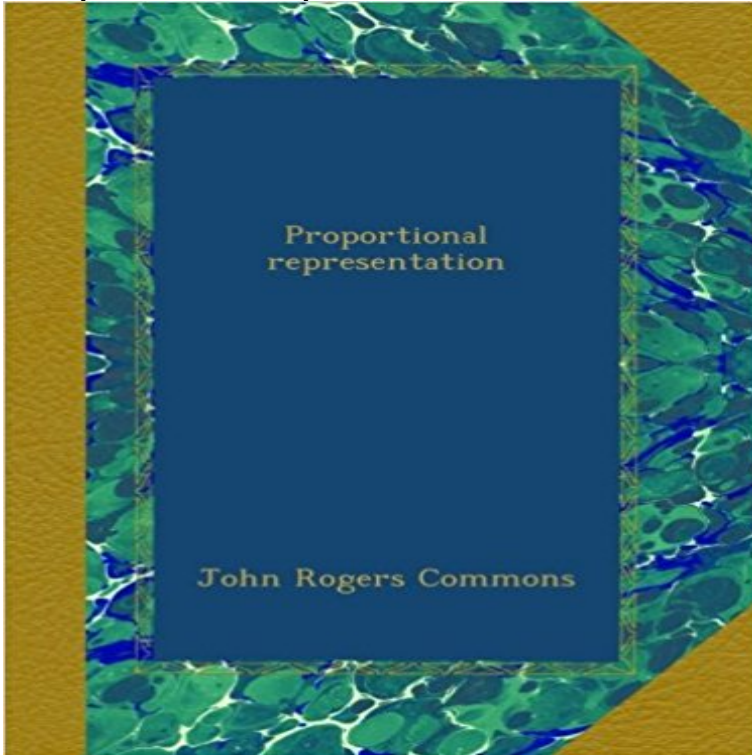


## Proportional representation
