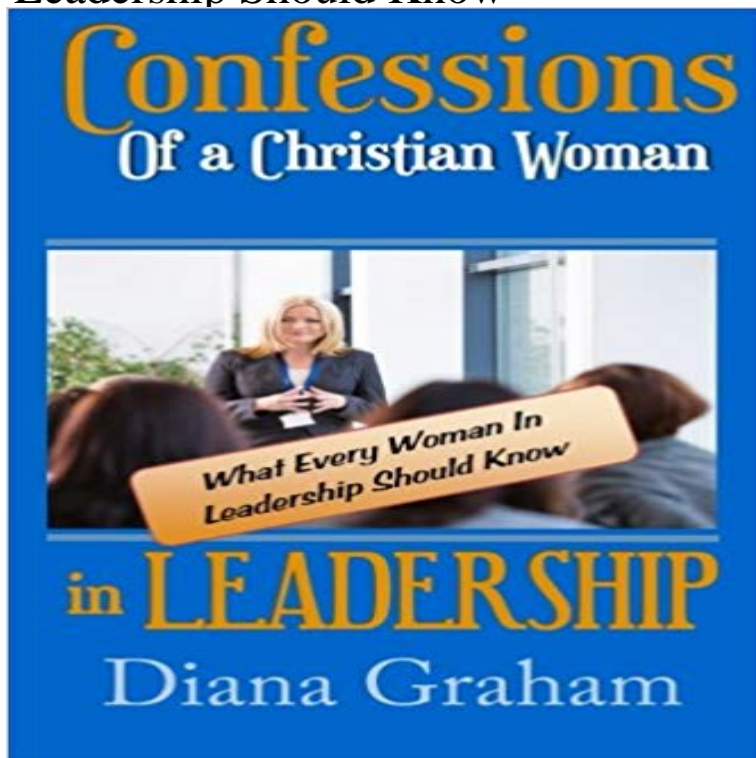


Confessions of a Christian Woman in Leadership: What Every Woman in Leadership Should Know
